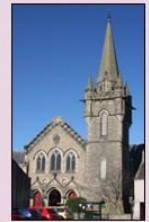

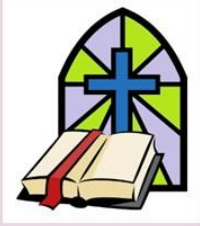
#### Healing Course
