As you will have noted above, the Guild resumes tomorrow after its extended summer break, when the guest speaker is our new Minister Elect.

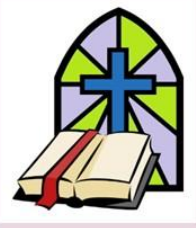
A warm welcome is extended to everyone (including men!) to enjoy the friendship and fellowship, which has long been the hallmark of the Guild. Go and find out for yourself!
